I was really nervous on stage as MC, and unfortunately I think it kind of showed, but luckily the comedians saved my butt

by giving amazing performances. TLGTA members, Stephen Sharpe and Doug Taylor, were especially amazing because we got to see a different side to them along with closer Ted Morris, who blew the crowd away with his brand of humour.
